Sunday, August 30th      **I Am Forgiven**

1 John 1: 8-10 (TPT) If we boast that we have no sin, we're only fooling ourselves and are strangers to the truth. 9 But if we freely admit our sins *when his light uncovers them*, he will be faithful to forgive us every time. God is just to forgive us our sins *because of Christ*, and he will continue to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 10 If we claim that we're not guilty of sin *when God uncovers it with his light*, we make him a liar and his word is not in us.

Jesus lived a sinless life to redeem us from our past lifestyles and the heaviness of shame. As we are diligent to confess our wrong doing, thinking, and feeling, God forgives us completely and eternally..."It is finished."

I declare that as I follow Jesus with purity of heart, no sin follows me. I am a forgiven!

Monday, August 31st      **I Am Chosen**

Ephesians 1:3-6 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ, 4 just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, 5 having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ

to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.

God had us in mind when He spoke the worlds into being. He chose every aspect of our being, handpicked our families, and gave each of us specific gifts and talents, in seed form, so that we would be made whole and holy by His love.

Tuesday, September 1st                    **I Am Free**

Galatians 5:1 (TPT) Let me be clear, the Anointed One has set us free—not partially, but completely and wonderfully free! We must always cherish this truth and stubbornly refuse to go back into the bondage of our past.

Galatians 5:13-14 For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not *use* liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. 14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, *even* in this: “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”

Jesus set us free from the burden of sin and settled our yesterdays once and for all. His life purchased liberty for our lives.

Wednesday, September 2nd                    **I Am Loved Unconditionally**

Ephesians 2:4-6 (TPT) But God still loved us with such great love. He is so rich in compassion and mercy. **5** Even when we were dead and doomed in our many sins, he united us into the very life of Christ and saved us by his wonderful grace! **6** He raised us up with Christ the exalted One, *and we ascended with him into the glorious perfection and authority* of the heavenly realm, for we are now co-seated<sup>[a]</sup> as one with Christ!

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

God is omnipotent, omnipresent, and omniscient. Not only does He know all that is to come, He also knows ALL that we have done...and He still loves us! God sees all and God sees us.

I declare that I am loved unconditionally!

Thursday, September 3rd **I Am Made New**

2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Colossians 3:9-11 (MSG) You're done with that old life. It's like a filthy set of ill-fitting clothes you've stripped off and put in the fire. Now you're dressed in a new wardrobe. Every item of your new way of life is custom-made by the Creator, with his label on it. All the old fashions are now obsolete. Words like Jewish and non-Jewish, religious and irreligious, insider and outsider, uncivilized and uncouth, slave and free, mean nothing. From now on everyone is defined by Christ, everyone is included in Christ.

As Believers, we have been adopted into God's family and therefore take on the characteristics of Christ. Regardless of the traits of our families of origin, grace now runs in our family!

Friday, September 4th **I Am Just**

Micah 6:8 (MSG) But he's already made it plain how to live, what to do, what God is looking for in men and women. It's quite simple: Do what is fair and just to your neighbor, be compassionate and loyal in your love, And don't take yourself too seriously —take God seriously.

Jesus walked the earth, dealt with life's stress, the many opinions of others, hard times, mistreatment, and witnessed the worst in people, yet without sin. He made this sacrifice

so that we would know how to graciously navigate through our lives, encouraging and bringing out the best in others.

I declare that I am humble, merciful, and I am just!

Saturday, September 5th

**I Am Able**

Philippians 4:12-13 (AMP) I know how to get along and live humbly [in difficult times], and I also know how to enjoy abundance *and* live in prosperity. In any and every circumstance I have learned the secret [of facing life], whether well-fed or going hungry, whether having an abundance or being in need. 13 I can do all things [which He has called me to do] through Him who strengthens *and* empowers me [to fulfill His purpose—I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency; I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses me with inner strength and confident peace.]

Jesus conquered sin, death, hell, and the grave so that we could live victoriously. As Believers, the very same power that raised Jesus from the grave lives in each of us. Through Christ we can be and do all that He has purposed for us to be and do.
