Sunday, 9/6 **All things are possible...**

Matthew 19:26 But Jesus looked at *them* and said to them, “**With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.**”

Psalms 84:11 For the Lord God is a sun and shield; The Lord will give grace and glory; No good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly.

The Lord *is* at hand. 6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard

your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

1 Peter 3:11 Let him turn away from evil and do good; Let him seek peace and pursue it.

**As I passionately seek peace and pursue it, God's goodness and mercy pursue me. He restores my soul and gives me the joy of the Lord as my strength.**

**I declare that as a follower of Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace, I am a purveyor of peace...and we are the peacemakers!**

Tuesday, 9/8 **Love is Possible**

I Corinthians 13:13 And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these *is* love.

Colossians 3:12-14 Therefore, as *the* elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also *must do*. 14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.

**Love is the foundation of a healthy spiritual life...loving our God and our neighbor. Grace is God's solution to the pains and disappointments of life. As He extended is grace to us, through love, while we were yet sinners, we too must extend grace and love...unconditionally!**

**I declare that I am loved by God, so much that He gave His son for me. I will share that love and be known as a Christ follower!**

Wednesday, 9/9 **The Miraculous is Possible**

Mark 11:22-25 (NKJV) (MSG) So Jesus answered and said to them, “**Have faith in God.** **23For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.** **24Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*.** **25“And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses.** **26But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses.”**

**God the Father is still in the miracle business, and we believe in the miraculous!  
There is nothing too hard for God and His power lives in us.**

**I declare that I as I daily choose God’s love, I miraculously always have enough to give away.**

Thursday, 9/10 **Healing is Possible**

Matthew 15:30-31 Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them *the* lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus’ feet, and He healed them. **31** So the multitude marveled when they saw *the* mute speaking, *the* maimed made whole, *the* lame walking, and *the* blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

Luke 4:40 When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them.

**God anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit and with power. Where Jesus found people in need, He was moved with compassion and healed them of their disease. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever more.**

**I declare that I am healed and I am whole!**

Friday, 9/11 **Unity is Possible**

Psalms 133:1 Behold, how good and how pleasant *it is* For brethren to dwell together in unity!

Acts 2:1 When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

Philippians 2:1-4 Therefore if *there is* any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, 2 fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, *being* of one accord, of one mind. 3 *Let* nothing *be done* through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others

better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

**Jesus came to the earth to model how we should live selflessly considering others above ourselves. He calls us to look at others with soft eyes and a tender heart. We are unified as we keep Jesus at the center and His teaching as the lens through which we see.**

**I declare that I will resist the polarizing pulls of the world and keep Jesus at the center of my life, and my eyes on His example. We are the Church!**

**Saturday, 9/12 Our Dreams are Possible**

Psalms 126:1-3 When the Lord brought back the captivity of Zion, We were like those who dream. 2 Then our mouth was filled with laughter, And our tongue with singing. Then they said among the nations, "The Lord has done great things for them." 3 The Lord has done great things for us, *And* we are glad.

Ephesians 3:20-21 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, 21 to Him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.
